

High above the valley, it is a technical course with hilly, winding fairways and fast greens that reward strategic and precise play. This course,

available exclusively to hotel guests and members, is host to the Ladies European Tour Access Series' Terre Blanche Ladies Open.

In addition, the resort sports a one-of-a-kind Albatros Golf Performance Centre. The "European Tour Performance Institute" is complete with a Leadbetter Academy and a Biomecaswing Centre where you can enjoy unique training facilities and sophisticated analysis.

Off the course, the Spa welcomes you in a breathtaking Provençal bastide offering the ideal setting for relaxation. Devoted to well-being, it features 14 treatment rooms where guests can indulge in a variety of bespoke massages and beauty treatments by Valmont. Bathed in natural daylight, the Spa showcases a 65-foot lap pool, an outdoor vitality pool, saunas, Jacuzzis, a fitness room and beauty salons as well as a tea room with terrace amidst a peaceful garden.

Being in the epicentre of fantastic countryside, the resort offers you the





chance to explore the medieval villages discovering local traditions or enjoying tasting at many wineries.
